



For those of you new to daffodil shows the 'seedling' classes are new flowers bred by growers by pollinating one flower with the pollen of another. The bulb may have taken five years or so to grow from seed to flowering-size bulb. I have had some snap shots enlarged to show how seed is obtained from flowers.

Along side the Daffodil Exhibit there will be entertainment and refreshments in the grounds. We welcome back *Ethereal*, celtic harpists,

and look forward to hearing *The Old Time String Band*. Morning and afternoon tea will be available along with a BBQ in the middle of the day. Recitals will also be held in the church over the weekend.


