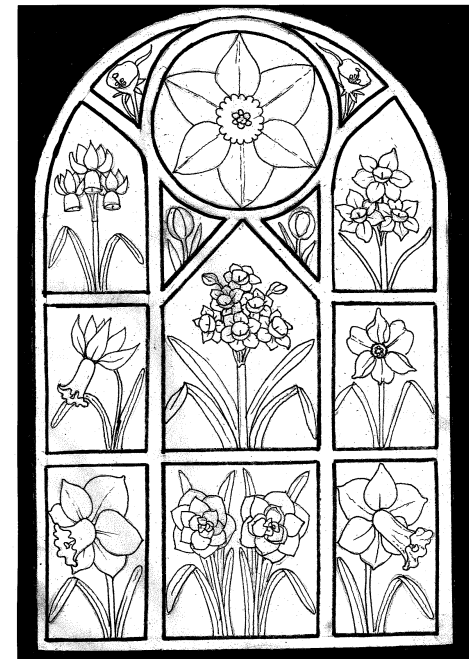

# Welcome to the 3rd Annual All Saints Daffodil Show

The vase theme for this years show is  
**TEAPOTS AND COFFEE POTS.**

General themes for this year's show include:  
swans, peacocks, ships, boats and trains.

The Davies family began collecting black teapots about 25 years ago as the result of a family 'intrigue' - ie which member of the family had 'the' black teapot spirited away in a cupboard? Finally it emerged and gradually acquired friends, a number of which will be on display at the show! They are Victorian English 'mourning-ware' also known as Jackfield ware - heavily black glazed earthenware.

I have recently returned from a trip around Western Europe travelling on trains and took many snap shots from my seat of landscapes, birds and animals. Along the way I visited the daffodil fields of Ron Scamp in Cornwall - about 15 acres of solid daffodil rows in every imaginable colour scheme. White swans seemed to appear from Sweden to Spain, Switzerland to Prague and the boats were photographed mainly around the Cornish coast.

I would ask that entries in Class 59 (Vase of 7 blooms) and the Breeder's Championship (Classes 61 and 62) be staged in either teapots or coffee pots. Our daffodil judge this year will be Pat Hallam. Karen Wagner will judge most of the Community Classes and Owen Davies will judge the art Classes 7 and 11.

There are two new classes this year, Community Classes 9 and 10. Class 9 **YOUTH DAFFODIL SHOW** will require the lodgement of 3 daffodils in separate bottles. Bottles and blooms will be provided (at no charge) at the show. If you've never entered a daffodil show before don't worry, there will be someone to assist you. Class 10 is **PLANT A WHEELBARROW** with a majority of vegetative material along the lines of this year's themes.

In Community Class 11 **BEST DAFFODIL ORIGINAL ART WORK** bonus points will be given to entries which include the themes of this year's show.

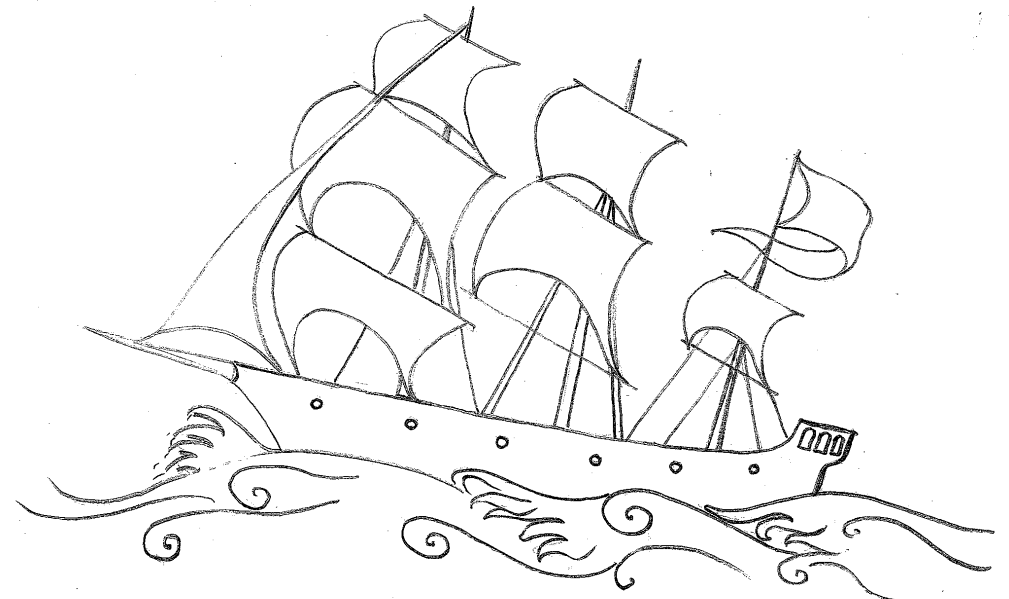

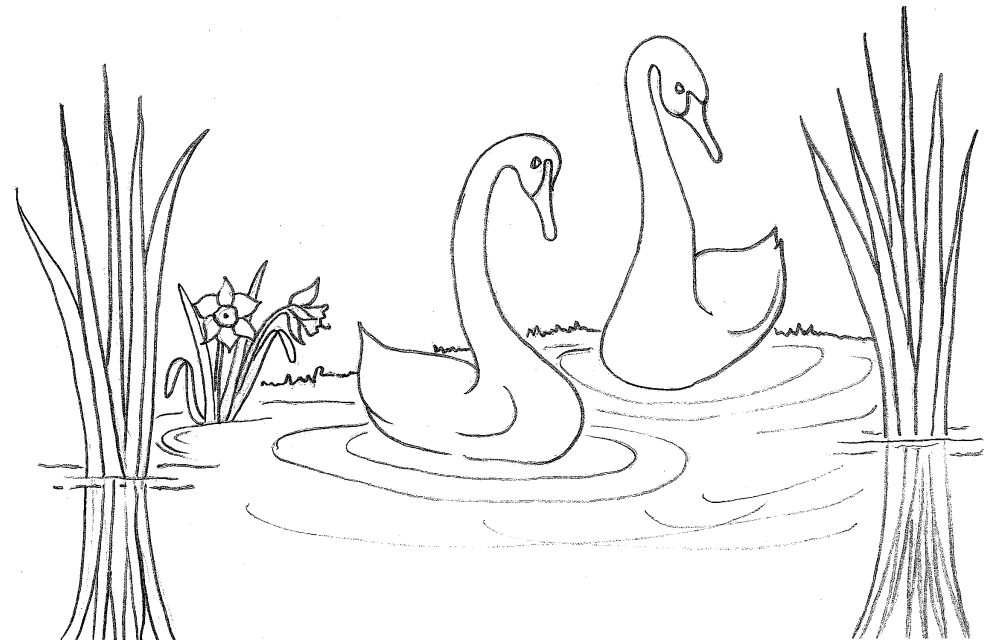

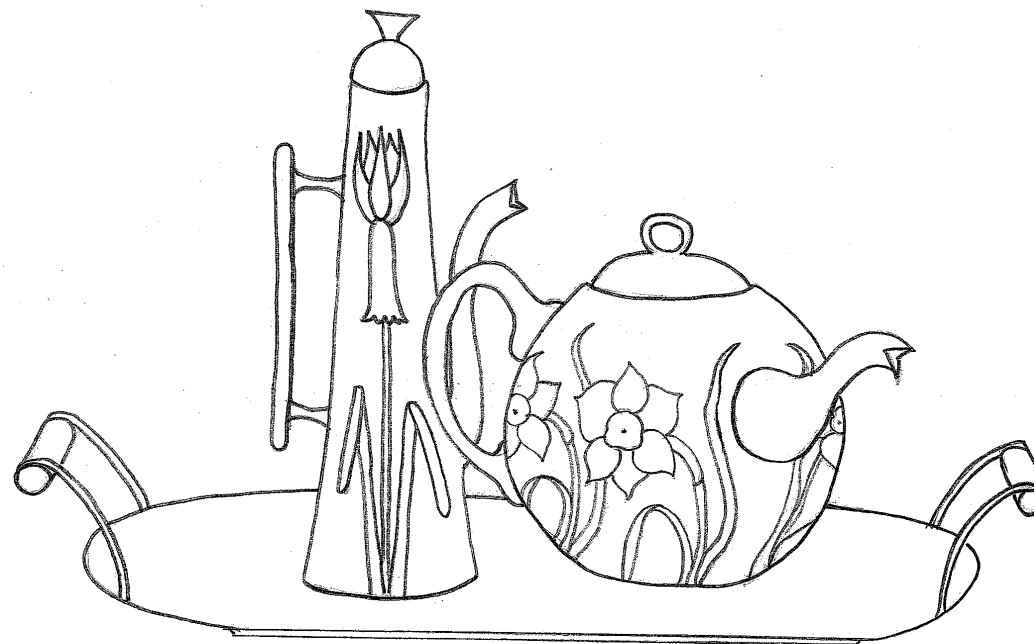
